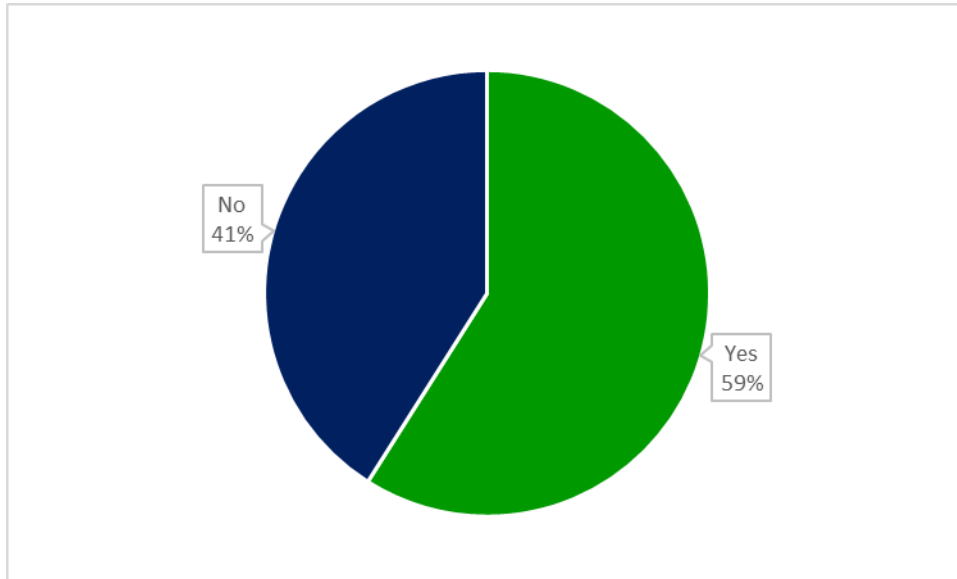


TOWN OF CASTOR SMOKING SURVEY RESULTS

Question #1: Would you like to see the radius of Smoke Free zones increased from 3 metres to 5 metres?



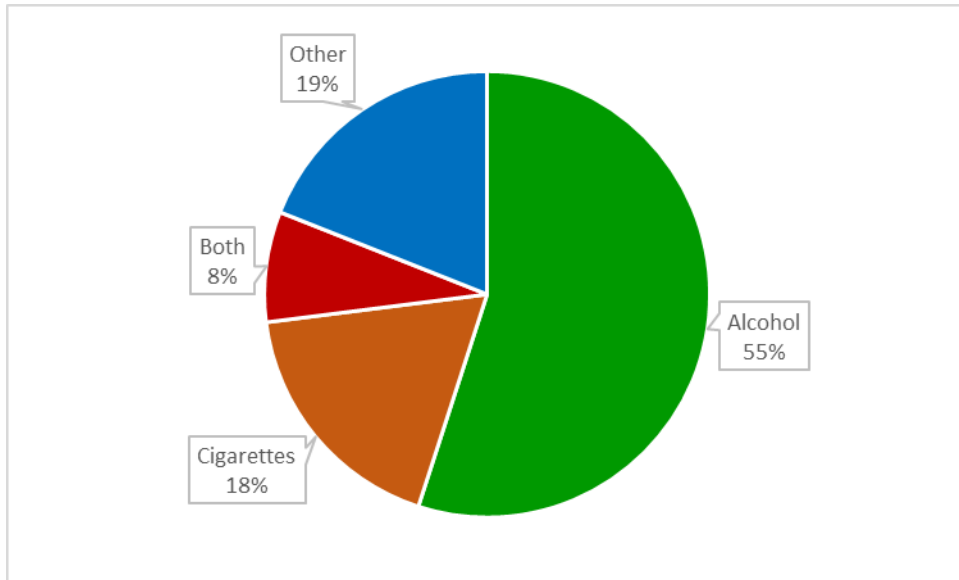
Comments:

- As far as joints same as alcohol not in public places.
- That way the smoke is not going to drift in and the smokers are not blocking the doors.
- People don't follow this as is, so maybe if it were increased they would actually move the 3 meters!
- 10 metres would be nice.

Question #2: Bylaw enforcement is often difficult and time consuming so the Town may need to look at hiring a Bylaw Enforcement Officer. To what extent would you want to see the Bylaw enforced? Keep in mind that full enforcement would include legal and court costs.

Of the survey respondents, 40% felt there was a need for increased enforcement of all Bylaws, with 20% indicating no need to increase enforcement of the Smoking Bylaw. An additional 21% felt that the town could not afford a Bylaw Enforcement Officer.

Question #3: Should the use of Cannabis be regarded the same as cigarette smoking OR the same as alcohol consumption?



Question #4: Given that "Public Place" is defined as: all or any part of a building, structure or other enclosed area to which members of the public have access as of right or by express or implied invitation. Would you be in favour or oppose a town Bylaw that would ban smoking (of any kind) in all public places including outdoor public spaces (such as parks, pool, ball diamonds, playgrounds)?
