

Town of Castor Employment Opportunity 2019 Summer Work Programs



1. The Town of Castor is accepting applications for summer employees under the 2019 Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) program and Summer Temporary Employment Program (STEP) to work from May 1 to Aug. 31, 2019. Hourly wage will range from \$17.00 - \$20.30 dependent upon experience or work history.
2. The Town of Castor is also accepting applications for summer employees to work from July 2 to Aug. 31, 2019. Hourly wage will range from \$15.00 - \$17.91 dependent upon experience or work history.

Applicants for all the above positions will be required to work a 40-hour work week within the public works, public utilities, and recreation/administration departments. Duties will include maintenance and repairs of public areas, boulevards, parks, roads, street signs, and a variety of other work. Manual labour is prevalent in these positions. All applicants must have a valid class 5 Drivers License and an abstract must accompany your application.

Pool/Camp Beaver Tail Staff

The Town of Castor invites applications for Lifeguards and Camp Counsellors for our 2019 May to September season at the Castor Centennial Outdoor Pool and Camp Beaver Tail.

Shifts may vary based on operational requirements.

Under the general supervision of the Recreation Director and/or Pool Manager, pool staff will perform lifeguarding functions and provide instruction in a number of aquatic programs and skills, as well as general maintenance, while camp staff will be required to plan, organize and implement camp activities and complete general cleaning duties.
