~ Castor Minor Hockey would like to Thank Everyone for a Great Year and look forward to seeing you all next season.

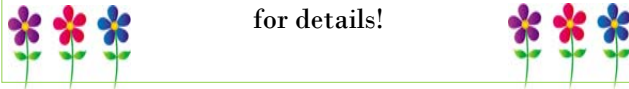

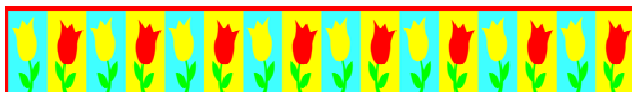

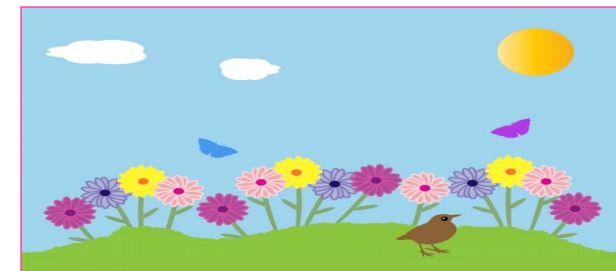
Spring is Here
