

TOWN OF CASTOR

BYLAW NO. 1007

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CASTOR IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ADOPT A MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS: pursuant to the provisions in Section 632(2) of the Municipal Government Act (R.S.A., 2000, Ch M-26.1) provides that a municipality having a population of less than 3500, may, by bylaw, adopt a plan to be known as:

“THE TOWN OF CASTOR MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN”

AND WHEREAS: a Public Hearing was held on April 11, 2011, as required by Section 230 of the Municipal Government Act.

NOW THEREFORE: THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTOR IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. This Bylaw may be cited as “The Town of Castor Municipal Development Plan.”
2. Council adopts as the Municipal Development Plan Bylaw for those lands contained within its civic boundaries, “The Town of Castor Municipal Development Plan.”
3. Bylaw Number 700 being the “Town of Castor General Municipal Plan” currently in Effect is hereby repealed including all amendments thereto and replaced by Bylaw Number 1007.

4. This Bylaw takes effect on the date of the third and final reading.
