BYLAW NO. 1047

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CASTOR TO PROVIDE FOR THE NUMBER OF COUNCILLORS AND THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL

Whereas, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act R.S.A. 2000 c. M-26, (Sections 143, 144, 150, and 151) as amended (the "Act"), Council may pass bylaws or municipal purposes respecting the Appointment of a Chief Elected Official and election of seven (7) Councillors;

And Whereas, it is desirable and in the best interest of the Town of Castor that a Bylaw be passed regulating, the Appointment of a Chief Elected Official and six (6) Councillors;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Castor, duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) That seven (7) Councillors be elected by the Town of Castor Voters, for the terms outlined in the Local Authorities Election Act;
- 2) That the Chief Elected Official (Mayor) be appointed by and from among the Councillors;
- 3) The appointment of the Chief Elected Official (Mayor) shall be for a period of (1) year from the date of initial appointment;
- 4) That the Appointment will begin the first organizational meeting held after the 2017 General Election;
- 5) That the Appointment will take place at each consecutive Organizational meeting beginning in 2018;
- 6) That this Bylaw shall come into force and have effect from and after the date of third reading thereof.
