NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF THE ASSESSMENT ROLL 2015 TOWN OF CASTOR, PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

Notice is hereby given that the Assessment Roll of the said Town of Castor made under the provisions of Section 311 of the Municipal Government Act. Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26 have been prepared and will be open to inspection at the office of the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Castor.

A complaint must be made in writing in accordance with Section 460 of the Municipal Government Act. Assessment Complaint Forms are available at the Town of Castor Municipal Office. A proper complaint must be filed no later than April 14th, 2014.

Dog Control

Dog Tags are now \$50.00. If you had a dog last year and forgot to renew the license fee, you will receive a bill in the mail.

Duties & Responsibilities of Dog Owners

- Dogs may not run at large at any time.
- If a dog defecates on property other than your own, you must remove the defecation and dispose of it in an appropriate waste receptacle.
- Dog owners are not allowed to have an accumulation of dog feces on their property that would constitute a nuisance.
- No owner of a dog shall allow their dog to howl, bark excessively, or become a nuisance. This prohibition is in effect 24 hours per day.
- Any "Dangerous Dog" must be confined within a secure enclosure and shall not be permitted outside of the enclosure unless it is on a permitted leash held under the control of the owner.
- There is a maximum of (3) three dogs over the age of (3) three months per dwelling unit.

The Household Hazardous Waste Roundup will be held on Saturday, May 30th, 2015. Even though it is four months away start thinking about getting your household hazardous materials together for proper disposal. The host community this year will be Castor with satellite pick ups in Coronation and Halkirk. Look for further information coming out in the bulletins and papers as we get closer to May 30th.

Cover and Tie Down Loads

Please remember to tarp and tie down loads when taking them to the Transfer Stations. For the most part residents are very good at keeping garbage from blowing or falling off vehicles, however garbage is still showing up on road allowances and access roads.

Empty Propane Tanks and Bottles

All three transfer stations accept empty propane tanks and bottles. They must be empty and propane tanks must have the valves open. Ask the Attendants where the drop off location is on the site. **DO NOT PLACE ANY PROPANE TANKS OR BOTTLES IN REGULAR GARBAGE BINS OR METAL PILES.**

Recycling Empty Oil Jugs, Pails and Filters

The Castor and Coronation Transfer Stations accept empty oil jugs, pails and filters for recycling. We still notice that people place these items in the regular garbage bins. Please be responsible and recycle them.

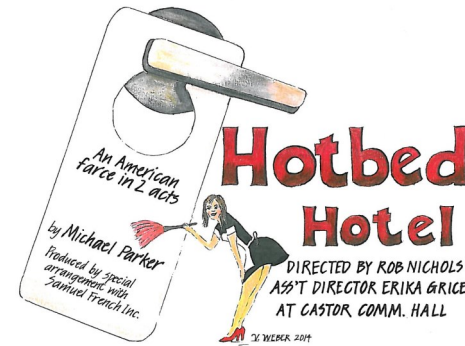

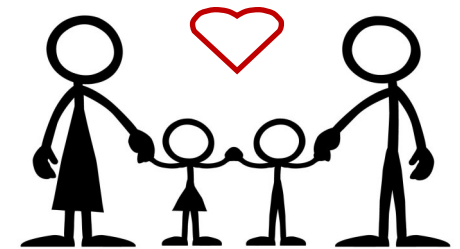
