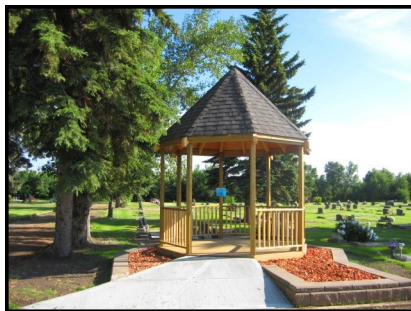

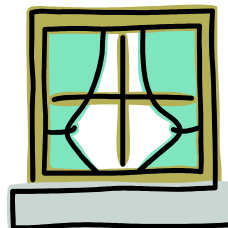
## FCSS CALLING ALL YOUTH

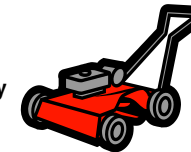

## REMINDER

Now that summer is here, the grass and weeds are growing, so the Town would like to remind everyone of Town Bylaw #993 that regulates untidy and unsightly premises. Owners are responsible to eradicate or control any weeds and to keep grass mowed on their property and any adjoining boulevards. Owners are also responsible to remove any dead grass, brush, or rubbish which may be untidy or unsightly.



If an owner is in contravention of the Bylaw, the Town may cause any work necessary to remedy the condition to be done, and may charge the cost of the work to the owner, plus a fine of \$300.00 for a first offense.
