#### General Recycling

General Recycling is going very well. One thing to remember is if you use plastic bags to place your recycling materials in, please do not use the black or dark green bags. The recyclers need to be able to see the materials in the bags. Black or dark green bags indicate that they are garbage bags which contain household garbage. If a black or dark green bag in found in the recycling bins, the bag has to be opened manually to make sure that regular household garbage is not being put with the recycling materials. PLEASE DO NOT USE BLACK OR DARK GREEN PLASTIC BAGS FOR RECYCLING.

Also, remember that styrofoam is not recyclable and needs to be placed into the regular garbage bins.

#### **Household Waste**

We have been asked what is household waste. "Household Waste" comprises of garbage and rubbish such as bottles, cans, clothing, compost, disposables, food packaging, food scraps, newspapers, magazines and yard trimmings. Just because items originate from within a house does not mean it is household waste. The garbage bins located at all three transfer stations are for household waste only. They are not to be use for furniture, mattresses, metals or building materials. Please do not place non household waste into the bins.
