REMINDER: BYLAW 999
WINTER TRAILER PARKING IN EFFECT

Please note that Recreation vehicles or trailers can no longer be parked on the roadway unless you are actually loading or unloading goods. Any vehicles parked in contravention of this Bylaw will be removed and impounded until claimed by the owners and a fine of \$50.00 (first offence) plus any impounding charges have been paid. Copies of ByLaw 999 are available at the Town Office.

Please note that all Trailers were to be removed from the boulevards and streets by **OCTOBER 1, 2015**. Any units that are in contravention of this bylaw will be towed and subject to the above mentioned fines.

1.4 billion litres of oil

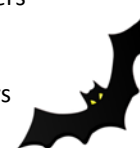

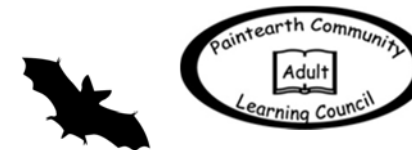
