Tire Recycling

PRWML has been notified by Liberty Tire Recycling that a lot of waste debris and non-recyclable tires are showing up when they are doing their collections. Items which are not acceptable include the following.

- ◆ Any type of tracks such as skid steers, snowmobiles or large equipment tracks.
- ◆ Any forklift tires that either have a steel band inside or are solid.
- ◆ Foam filled tires nor the foam fill product itself.
- ◆ Debris such as plastics, belting, pails, wood, rubber hosing, tire tubes or any such things that are not tires.

Liberty Tire Recycling will discontinue service if the amount of non-recyclable products continues to be problematic and continuous.

We ask that residents be careful when disposing of tires and that waste materials be placed in their appropriate bins.

Empty Paint Cans

If you have empty paint cans they are to be placed in the metal piles. Alberta Recycling Authority's paint recycling program does not cover empty cans.

Waste Sorting

We continue to find materials at our sites which are not disposed of properly. Garbage is placed in metal piles, metals are found in the garbage bins, paint cans are found in garbage bins. Hazardous waste materials are found in various places on transfer sites, usually because the person knows we are not supposed to have those materials on site. Transfer Stations operate with specific guidelines which are enforced by Alberta Environmental Protection. The operation of our sites is in jeopardy when hazardous materials are on site. Make sure your waste is sorted prior to coming to the transfer stations and is placed in it's proper location. Hazardous Household materials can be disposed of properly when we hold the Annual Household Hazardous Waste Roundup. Your co-operation would be most appreciated. If you are unsure of where a product should be put, please ask the Attendant on site.
