General Garbage Bins

At all the transfer stations we have noticed that a lot of lumber and metal material are being placed in the general garbage bins. This type of material can cause damage to the bin pick up truck. Please place these materials in the proper metal recycling area or in the case of lumber in the demolition bunkers at Castor or Halkirk and in Coronation take it to the Progressive Waste Services site. A lot of recyclable materials such as food cans, plastic containers, paper and cardboard are placed in the general garbage containers. By recycling we save the cost of landfilling materials and also have a product made for future use. The number of pop bottles, beer cans and beverage containers being thrown away instead of being taken to a bottle recycler is alarming. These containers can be reused as well as your getting paid for them. We all have a responsibility to be proactive with recycling, so please make the effort to recycle.

Propane Tanks

All three transfer stations are set up to take **empty** propane tanks. Please leave the valves opened so that the attendant knows the tanks are empty. The small camp stove type tanks are also collected. Check with the attendant for directions for disposal.

Cell Phones

Old cell phones are accepted for recycling. The cells phones are collected at all the sites, then they are sent away to be disassembled properly and securely. Just ask the attendant and he will assist you to recycled unwanted cell phone.

Railway Right of Way

Just a reminder that the railway right of way is a utility corridor and recreational vehicles are prohibited from using the right of way. Only authorized persons are allowed on the right of way.

Driving with Caution

All the transfer stations have a posted speed limit of 25km/hr. The sites can get very busy at the bins or the various bunkers, please drive with due care and caution when using the sites.

REMINDER

School is back in session as of September 2, 2015. In the excitement of heading back for a new school year children may forget about the basic road safety rules. Please obey the speed limits and keep a close eye out for the children of our community.

The speed limit in a school zone is 30 km/h unless otherwise posted and is in effect on school days from 8 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and 3 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. unless other times are posted. The speed limit in a playground zone is 30 km/h unless otherwise posted and is in effect from 8:30 a.m. to one hour after sunset. A vehicle is not permitted to pass another vehicle travelling in the same direction in either school or playground zones during the times that these zones are in effect.
